1. Pickleball Noise

- 1. After investigating possible sound panel options for the east side of the tennis court, the Board found that the expensive panels are not very effective in reducing sound.
 - i. Because sound panels are not a reasonable solution to the pickleball noise problem, president Michelle Baker reached out to the homeowner most impacted by the noise to ascertain a set of pickleball rules that might be used to keep HOA members playing pickleball but also create a safe space for the homeowner.
 - ii. The Board will evaluate the new rules regularly and will end pickleball play permanently if necessary.
- 2. Tennis Court Rules for Pickleball
 - 1. Pickleball play will be allowed daily from 9:00 am to 11:00 am and from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
 - 2. Pickleball will only be allowed on the west court.
 - 3. Court usage will be limited to one hour per session.
 - 4. An HOA member can only have three guests per session.
 - 5. Green Zone paddles are required for pickleball play.
 - 6. Indoor balls are required for pickleball play.
 - ii. Because enforcing the pickleball rules is problematic, the HOA is relying on the honor system.
- 3. Tennis Court Parking
 - i. Visitors to the courts will be encouraged to park on Hays Drive or at the home of the CVEHOA member host instead of Barberry Circle.
- 4. The tennis court combination will be changed.
 - i. HOA members will be required to contact Michellle Baker (or Dan Nichols in her absence) to obtain the combination.
 - ii. An e-mail containing the pickleball rules will be sent to the member.
 - iii. The member will need to respond to the e-mail and indicate that they understand and will abide by the rules.
 - iv. The combination will be sent to the member at that time.
 - v. Once the combination is received, it should never be shared with anyone.
- 5. The Board will take the following actions by October 6, 2023.
 - i. Temporary signage containing pickleball rules will be posted.
 - ii. A box containing Green Zone paddles and indoor balls will be installed inside the tennis court. These paddles and balls should be used if players don't currently own the required equipment.
 - iii. Temporary pickleball lines will be installed on the west court.
